→ HUD offering Pierce County housing providers opportunity to learn more about HEARTH Act

...and the necessity for high quality data to share your program's success. *The purpose of this training is to help participants understand the role of HMIS in evaluating community efforts to end homelessness, explain the importance of data quality in measuring agency and system-level performance and to identify areas of further planning and training around data issues.*

The U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) provides technical assistance (TA) to Pierce County through the OneCPD initiative. The HUD TA providers have scheduled a 2-part HMIS training opportunity for Homeless and ESG providers in Pierce County. This web-based training will provide a forum for information sharing around enhancing HMIS data collection, quality, and usage; and opportunities for participants to discuss effective strategies. A primary goal of the training is to help recipients learn to "tell their story" to community partners, stakeholders, HUD and other funders through high quality HMIS-based data.

Part 1: Tuesday, September 10th, 10AM-11:30AM

This training will review HUD Regulations in regards to Continuum of Care and Emergency Solutions Grant and provide an overview of the HEARTH Act. HMIS will be discussed in relation to the HEARTH Act and the necessity for high quality data, utilization of your data to support your work.

Part 2: Tuesday, September 17th, 10AM-11:30AM

This training will review Part 1, performance measurement to determine program and community success and how to share your story through reporting.
